Understanding the World


Create your own fact file for your favourite minibeast. This could be drawn, written or using pictures. Include a picture of your minibeast, where it lives, what it eats and any other information you find relevant.

Take turns to roll a dice and draw parts of the spider's body. The first person to complete their spider is the winner.

Expressive Arts & Design


Create your own spider's web using a basket. Use string or wool to create your web. Use tongues or tweezers to 'catch' objects through the web.



Literacy – Writing


Write a list of the animals in the story.

Extension- Write two or three sentences about some of the characters.

Literacy-Reading/Phonics

Practise reading the Phase 3 captions attached and match to the correct picture. Then ask a parent to read the caption whilst you write it down.

e.g. Digging in the soil.



Maths-Counting

Using a bag of pasta or the equivalent, group the pasta pieces into sets of 2. Practise counting in 2's up to 20.

Extension – Group into 5's or 10's and count.



Maths-Number

Cut out a circle and collect 8 pegs. This will be your spider. Clip the pegs onto the side of the spider's body using different combinations.



Record the different number bonds to 8
e.g. $1 + 7 = 8$
