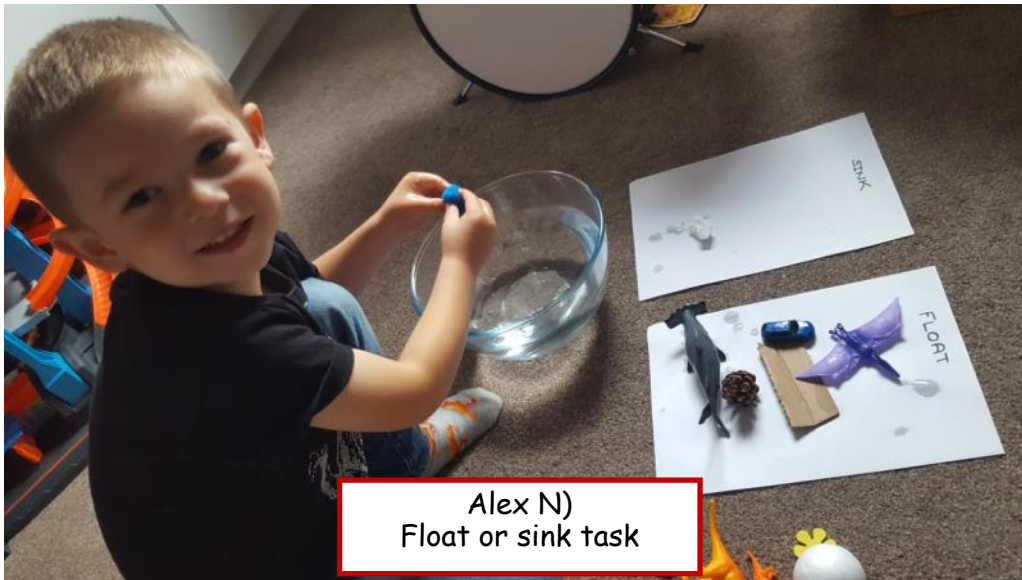

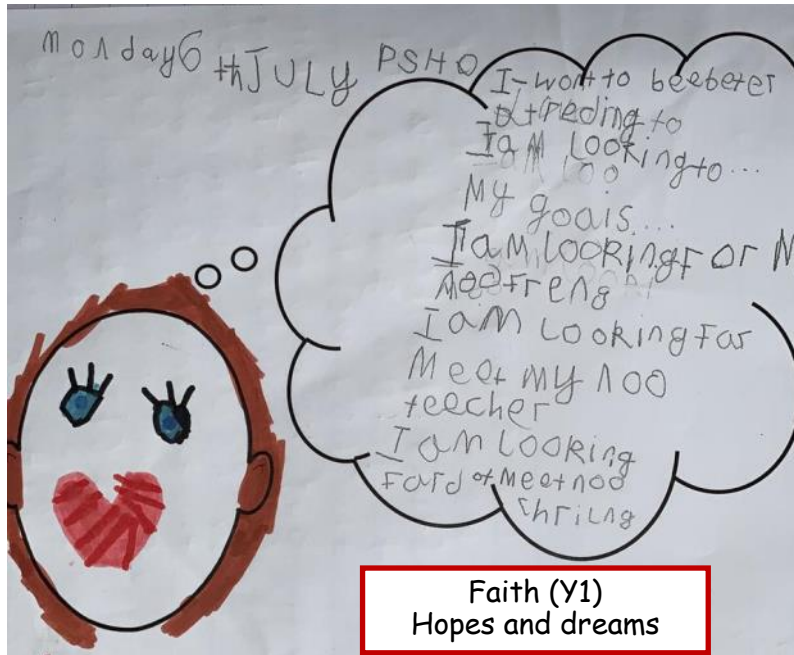
My aspirations for Y6

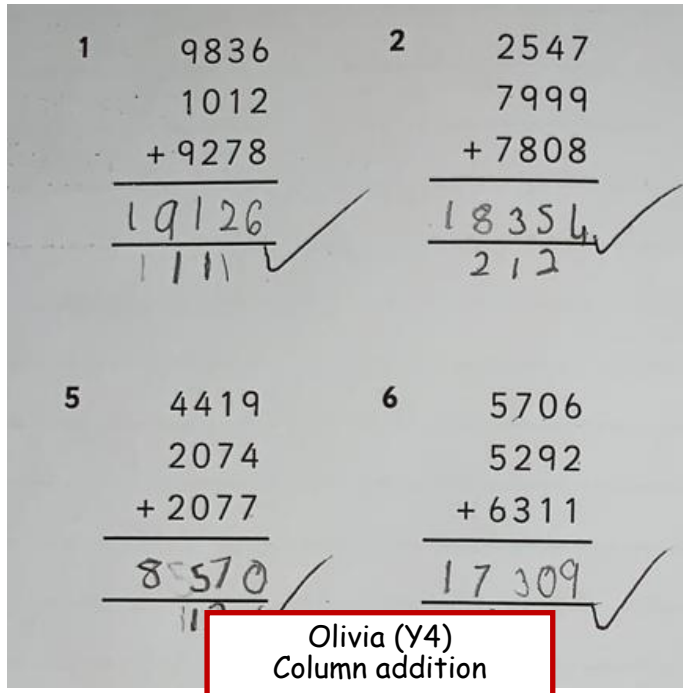
