For books to share with your child, use Oxford Owl for School and Home

Your child will have reading books from school to read at home every two weeks. Please re-read these texts to encourage pace and fluency, in addition to asking lots of questions about the story, the pictures, predicting what might happen next etc.

There are also lots of texts and tasks on Purple Mash for your child to access if they wish (one text has been set for this half term but it is not an expectation that it is completed at home now that your child has their usual school reading books).

N.B. The Twinkl Phonics Powerpoints lead you through the entire lesson with refresher sound activities to begin, a story to introduce and consolidate the new sound and activities to complete as you progress. It may be worth quickly reading through before completing with your child to ensure your and their full understanding. The children usually help to read the story text that is in purple or red and an adult reads the black. When you have completed the powerpoint, there is a resource for an additional task for you to complete with your child to give them an opportunity to practise using the new sound in a fun way. This activity could be printed or written on to paper as you wish.
